



Section 20 - Exception Process

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The Exception Process is a formal process under which the Division of Medical Services may grant an exception and authorize an essential medical service or item of equipment that otherwise exceeds the benefits and limitations set in policy.

Section 20, Exception Process, is *not* applicable to the following manuals, because services *cannot* be approved in accordance with the exception process regulation.
